All of our buildings are made to order and handcrafted using traditional carpentry techniques by skilled craftsmen, which are then delivered and installed by our own teams of experienced fitters across the country.

The Malvern Collection design and make a wide collection of buildings, from the humble shed right through to fully lined, insulated and double glazed garden rooms and offices designed for all year round use. We offer a wide selection of optional extras which enable you to create your ideal garden room to meet not only your practical needs but also your own personal taste.

Our paint spraying shop is one of the most advanced spraying and drying facilities in the garden building industry, where buildings can be coated with a highly durable and weather resistant, low maintenance paint and primer system, which will protect and enhance your building.

At Malvern, we use only the highest quality materials from sustainable sources. Our redwood and thermowood clad buildings are constructed using kiln dried slow grown pine from Sweden's Northern sawmills and our cedar buildings are constructed using Canadian Western Red kiln dried cedar. Millboard® composite cladding is an alternative to timber providing a low-maintenance, durable and fade-free appearance.





The drawings below show our standard layout with single sliding door centred and where size permits, glazing to the front with medium and large windows. Medium top opening window in each side.



GLOSSARY OF TERMS

EXTERNAL CLADDING

We offer a choice of timber claddings, both vertical and horizontal styles are available. These include:-

REDWOOD

Our FSC certified, kiln dried, slow grown Scandinavian redwood is from Sweden's northern sawmills. Being slow grown in colder climates means our redwood is durable, stable, sustainable and hardwearing, making it a reliable and long lasting timber option for your building.

THERMOWOOD

Thermowood is a heat treated redwood that has been thermally modified using specialised kilning techniques. Thermal modification is a natural, toxin free process that changes the cell structure of the wood by heating it to over 200°C. This removes moisture and resin resulting in a cladding that is stable, durable and resistant to decay. The process also minimises the risk of warping and shrinkage. This process makes Thermowood an ideal cladding when a painted finish is preferred.

CEDAR

Rich in colour and naturally durable, Canadian Western Red Cedar is the natural choice for cladding. With its warm tones, fine grain and incredible longevity, it brings timeless beauty to any building.

MILLBOARD® COMPOSITE CLADDING

Millboard® cladding is composed of recycled materials and renewable biopolymers to create a realistic wood grain appearance and a low maintenance solution. Available in a selection of various colour finishes, Millboard® cladding has been UV stabilised for better performance and fade protection as well as resistant to mould and fungus.

COLOURED PAINTED FINISH

A comprehensive paint system is applied prior to the building leaving the factory. The paint system comprises of an initial undercoat and a further top coat of your chosen colour.

CLEAR LACQUER

A translucent clear lacquer is sprayed on top of timber treatment.

TONGUE & GROOVE LINING AND SOLID BOARD CAVITY INSULATION

Building is internally lined with U-foil insulation and covered with redwood tongue and groove matchboard. 40mm solid board cavity insulation can be fitted as an alternative to U-foil insulation.

WHITWASHED TONGUE & GROOVE LINING

As above but all the roofs, walls and floor have a translucent whitewashed coating applied.

PAINTED MDF LINING AND SOLID BOARD CAVITY INSULATION

Building is internally lined with U-foil insulation and covered with a painted MDF moisture resistant tongue and groove board. Available in Ghost White, Soft White, Vintage White and White Smoke. 40mm solid board cavity insulation can be fitted as an alternative to U-foil insulation.

EPDM RUBBER ROOF

A maintenance free synthetic rubber membrane covering the roof as an alternative to roofing felt.

BITUMEN FELT TILES

Roof is covered with tile effect heavy duty felt tiles.

METAL ROOFS

Polyester coated profiled steel sheeting. Available in six colour options.

SLATE EFFECT ROOF TILE

Slate effect roof tile is a synthetic roof tile which emulates the appearance of natural slates and has a long life span with no maintenance.

CEDAR SHINGLE ROOF

Western Red cedar shingles fixed to pressure treated joists to enhance the appearance of your building and provide added protection to the roofing felt beneath.

INTEGRAL OPEN SIDED AREA

Studio's can be divided into rooms with an open space decking area. Timber decking is used for this open area, with composite decking available as an upgrade. When choosing the open side option heavy duty flooring must be included for the whole of the building footprint.

COMPOSITE DECKING

A high density, heavy duty and weather resistant wood composite.

LAMINATES

Premium hard wearing laminate flooring with a wide range of styles to choose from.

ENGINEERED OAK FLOORING

Engineered wood flooring is constructed in a way that it provides better stability and resistance to variations in temperature and moisture. It looks like solid wood flooring as the top layer is real solid wood, but it then has a plywood base construction underneath.

GUTTERING

Guttering is available in a choice of three colours - black, brown or white.

TINTED GLASS

All glazing has one side with an anti-sun tint applied to the unit.

Important Points

to note

All of our Garden Rooms come with a comprehensive guarantee from a company that has been manufacturing and installing buildings for over 50 years. Our buildings have a 10 year structural guarantee which includes rot and decay. All other workmanship and materials are guaranteed for a minimum of 2 years. Full details are provided in our guarantee guidelines.

Our recommendations are that all timber garden structures require ongoing maintenance following installation. Redwood, thermowood and cedar require annual timber treatment to be applied, ideally prior to the colder wetter months for added protection. We recommend all spray painted buildings are maintained on an annual basis, inspect the painted areas on the building, checking for any areas where the paint finish maybe starting to deteriorate over time, peeling or flaking and repaint where necessary. A full guide of maintenance guidelines are available on request.

All base work is the responsibility of the customer, as is the safe securing of the building once installed. We require a level solid base, either paving slabs, decking or concrete upon which to install your building. In the event of a base failure, it is the customers responsibility to accept delivery of the building, safely and store appropriately.

Please allow as much room as possible around the building for our fitters to work during installation, a minimum of 450mm. If this is not possible please contact the office to discuss.

Our installers will need clear access to carry building sections from the vehicle to your prepared base, with no height restrictions or tight, sharp corners to negotiate.

Our installers cannot lift sections over 1.22m in height or over buildings such as garages. If the only access is through the house, a straight run is required and many sections will not pass through doorways. Please advise us in advance if there are any difficulties regarding access.

Always make allowance for any roof overhang when buildings have to go into confined spaces.

All garden rooms have redwood framing. All floors have composite joists with redwood floorboards and roofs have redwood joists with 15mm OSB roof boards.

All building dimensions shown in this brochure are approximate, based on floor sizes.






